All riders will participate in Ridden Best Turned Out and Gymkhana Games in the morning. Please choose two of the jumping classes for the afternoon (can be the same class more than once).

Please let the office know by Wed 30th May which classes you would like to do.

Preparation

Arrive from **9am** onwards so you will have plenty of time to get your horse/pony, your tack and yourself looking your best before the classes start at 10am. Liveries to catch in their own horse/pony. Please note that parents must not help with this preparation to make things fair for all competitors. Parents are invited to come back and watch the Gymkhana and jumping classes starting at 11.15am.

It is a good idea to wear old clothes while you get ready and then change into your smart clothes just before the classes start. Please make sure you are in Pony Club Competition attire where possible, including a hairnet for long hair.

Come prepared for all weather conditions & don't forget to bring some lunch!















Ridden Best Turned out

All competitors to take part. This will include a proper inspection!

Gymkhana Games

All competitors to take part. Enjoy some of the very best Gymkhana games including weave & jump and the sack race!

Ride & Run (class 1)

Ride a course of jumps on your pony and then dismount and run around the same course as fast as you can! Fastest time wins.

Pairs Relay (class z)

Jump this class with a partner – one of you jumps the course as fast as you can without knocking any fences, then return to the start box and your partner will do the same! Fastest pair wins.

Top Score (class 3)

Each fence in this course will be of a different height and difficulty, each with their own points value displayed on it. Score as many points as possible in the time allowed by jumping your own combination of fences!

Bucket Elimination (class 4)

Jump over a line of buckets. Sound simple? The line of buckets will get smaller each time until there is only one rider left!


