Situated 2 miles outside of Chichester, West Sussex, we are a friendly, professional riding school, the best place to learn to ride well and safely. All of our horse stalls, indoor riding school and yard are on one level and easily accessible. We encourage visitors to meet the team, horses and ponies. Located in 80 acres of beautiful West Sussex countryside, we have our own woodlands and pasture fields nestling within the South Downs National Park.

The stable yard and administration office are manned during normal working hours, with professional staff members always on hand to assist and advise. We look forward to welcoming you. By vehicle, bus or bicycle, approaching from either north or south, take the A286 Chichester to Midhurst Road which goes through the centre of Lavant. Once reaching mid-Lavant, follow the black and white highway signs for directions to Lavant Equestrian's entrance.

The nearest railway station is Chichester, approximately 3.5 miles distant. Taxis are available from the station, or one can cycle directly north from the station using Centurion Way.

There is a large, level car park for approximately 50 cars with ample space for disabled parking. This is also where the Fire Assembly Point is clearly on display. All visitors are requested to go to the main office which is situated at the end of the main stable yard by following the "Reception" signs in situ from the car park. The entire area is made up of flat, solid surfaces which are suitable for pushchairs, wheelchairs and disabled people carriers.

Once on site all horses may only be approached with a staff member present. Children have to remain with a responsible adult at all times. Dogs (other than guide dogs) are not permitted on the premises and smoking or vaping is strictly forbidden. There are three arenas with sheltered and heated seating areas for spectators with complimentary tea, coffee and filtered water available as required.
